Sec. 1. 39-A MRSA §102, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 885, Pt. A, §8 and affected by §§9 to 11, is amended to read:

3. Aquaculture. "Aquaculture" means the commercial culture, pounding or husbandry of oysters, clams, scallops, mussels, salmon er, trout or lobsters.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill amends the definition of aquaculture to include 14 employees whose work involves lobsters under the alternative liability and medical insurance provisions provided by the Maine 16 Workers' Compensation Act of 1992.
