	This bill may reduce the number of Class D crimes.
28	Sentences imposed for Class D offenses must be served in a county jail. The average cost per sentence for a Class D crime is
30	\$7,439 based upon an average length of stay of 119 days. The resulting savings from reductions in the number of Class D crimes
32	will accrue to the counties.
34	The Judicial Department also may realize some savings from reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with
36	the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed in the court system. Reductions in the collection of fines may decrease
38	General Fund revenues by a minor amount.'
