Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §1014, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

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4. Former Legislator. A former Legislator may not
6 knowingly act before the Legislature as an agent or attorney, or
appear personally, for anyone other than the State for 2 years
8 following termination of the Legislator's term of office.

10 For purposes of this subsection, "Legislature" includes any legislative committee, subcommittee or any board or commission in
12 which a member of the Legislature participates.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill proposes that former Legislators be prohibited from serving as lobbyists for a period of 2 years immediately following their departure from the Legislature.
