

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4710 is enacted to read:

6 **§4710. Instruction in fine arts**

8 Sequential instruction in fine arts is required. Fine arts
10 instruction must be provided by certified specialists through
12 separate or integrated study and must include instruction in
14 awareness, appreciation and performance of art forms.

16 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

18 This bill requires that fine arts instruction be provided by
certified specialists and include instruction on awareness,
appreciation and performance of art forms.
