#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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	Sec. 1. Department waiver request. The Department of Human
4	Services shall apply within 30 days of the effective date of this
	Act to the federal Department of Health and Human Services for a
6	waiver under the Medicaid program to provide home-based care
	services for persons with HIV/AIDS. The department shall notify
8	the Joint Standing Committee on Human Resources by January 15,
	1994 of the status of the waiver application.
