## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §4062, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1985, c. 521, is further amended to read:

б 1. Payments by department. The department shall provide payments to facilities caring for children to meet the costs of 8 clothing, board and care, within the limits of available funds. The department may establish, by rule, different categories of 10 facilities, levels of need and and flat-rate care or reimbursement methods to distribute these funds. The department 12 may provide child care and travel expense payments to foster and adoptive parents and trainers participating in foster and 14 adoptive parent training programs and volunteers participating in the administrative case review program. <u>Payments to foster</u> 16 parents for travel expenses must be based on a rate of at least <u>30¢ per mile.</u>

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill ensures that foster parents are reimbursed for travel expenses at a rate of at least 30¢ per mile.

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
