COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 685, L.D. 926, Bill, "An Act to Allow Disclosure of Residential Electrical Costs"

16 Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its 18 place the following:

'Sec.1. 14 MRSA c.710-C is enacted to read:

### CHAPTER 710-C

#### DISCLOSURE OF RESIDENTIAL UTILITY COSTS

#### <u>§6045. Disclosure of electric utility costs</u>

Upon request, an electric utility, as defined in Title 35-A, 28 section 102, shall provide free of charge to current or 30 prospective customers, tenants or property owners residential electric energy consumption and cost information for a dwelling 32 unit for the prior 12-month period or figures reflecting the highest and lowest electric energy consumption and cost for the 34 previous 12 months. If a unit has been occupied for a period of less than 12 months, the electric utility shall estimate the unit's annual kilowatt-hour consumption and cost. Provision of 36 this information is neither a breach of customer confidentiality nor a guarantee or contract by the utility as to future 38 consumption levels for that unit. For purposes of this section, 40 "dwelling unit" includes mobile homes, apartments, buildings or other structures used for human habitation.'
