4. Lawful public access to certain recreational uses required. Beginning in tax year 1994, lawful access by the public for hunting, fishing or trapping may not be prohibited on lands subject to the provisions of this chapter. Imposition of a requirement of prior permission or reasonable fees does not constitute denial of access for these purposes.

This bill requires that beginning in tax year 1994, owners of property who receive a publicly funded reduction in property tax levy under the tree growth provisions of state law not prohibit the public from lawfully hunting, fishing or trapping on that property.
