26	Public Law 1991, chapter 855, Part A, section 322 eliminates the Appellate Division of the Workers' Compensation Commission
28	and provides for direct appeals to the Law Court on questions of law. This bill gives the Judicial Department the authority and
30	funds needed to hire a staff attorney to handle the increased caseload associated with workers' compensation appeals that will
32	now be filed with the Law Court.
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
