Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Natural Areas Program may be established within the Department of Community and Economic Development as of July 1, 1993; and

Whereas, this bill provides the transfer of staff to the 10 program; and

12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 16 safety; now, therefore,

18 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20 Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
