COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 326, L.D. 978

The Maine Sardine Council, Saco River Corridor Commission and the Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission will incur some minor additional costs to pay for the increase of unemployment compensation taxes. These costs can be absorbed within the agencies' existing budgeted resources.

The Baxter State Park Authority may need to adjust its allocation to pay for this increase. The amounts can not be determined at this time.

The increase in unemployment compensation taxes will increase costs for 195 municipalities and local units of government. The total additional costs are estimated to be \$93,583 and \$49,751 for calendar years 1993-94 and 1994-95, respectively. A recent Attorney General's opinion indicated that these additional costs are not subject to reimbursement as a state mandate pursuant to the Constitution of Maine.'
