Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §1502, 4th  $\P$ , as enacted by PL 1989, c. 757, is amended to read:

The State Police may provide assistance to federal agencies fer-presidential-security. The Chief of the State Police may charge the various federal agencies for these services. Revenues received from these agencies shall <u>must</u> be allocated for the purpose of funding the cost of providing the services.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

16 The State Police provides specialized assistance to several federal agencies. The assistance includes canine support,
18 underwater recovery and security for activities other than presidential details. This bill affords the State Police a
20 mechanism to recoup the costs for these additional activities.
