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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment adds several categories to the list of people authorized to possess hypodermic needles and clarifies that the Board of Commissioners of the Profession of Pharmacy may authorize agricultural supply stores to sell hypodermic needles. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
