Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §4641-B, 5th ¶, as amended by PL 1983, c. 859, Pt. M, §10, is further amended to read:

Each register of deeds shall, on or before the 10th day of each month, pay over to the State Tax Assessor 90% 75% of the tax collected during the previous month. The Of the remaining 10% shall 25%, 1/2 must be retained for the county by-the-register-of deeds-and-accounted-for-to-the-county-treasurer-as-reimbursement for-services-rendered-by-the-county-in-collecting-the-tax and 1/2 must be retained for the account of the county sheriff to provide and oversee court security.

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill changes the percentage of real estate taxes delivered to the State Tax Assessor and requires that 1/2 of the amount retained is applied to the account of the county sheriff to provide and oversee court security.
