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Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1491, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 452, §1, is amended to read:

### §1491. Occupational disease reporting

As used in this chapter the term "occupational disease" means any abnormal condition or disorder, ether-than-resulting frem--an-occupational--injury including an occupational injury, caused by exposure to environmental factors associated with employment. Occupational diseases shall include the following: Asbestosis; mesothelioma; silicosis; and exposure to heavy metals. Reporting of other occupational diseases may be required only by departmental rules.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill includes occupational injury in the definition of "occupational disease" as it relates to reportable conditions under the occupational disease reporting system.
