Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §1549, first ¶, as repealed and replaced by PL 4 1977, c. 78, §159, is amended to read:

The State Police, the sheriffs and the chiefs of police in each of the cities and towns shall-have-the-authority-to may take or cause to be taken, and upon payment of a \$1 <u>\$3</u> fee, shall take or cause to be taken, the fingerprints or palm prints, or fingerprints and palm prints, of any person who shall--request requests that his the person's fingerprints or palm prints, or fingerprints and palm prints, be taken.

STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This bill increases the fee for fingerprinting and palm printing services by a law enforcement agency at the request of a 20 citizen from \$1 to \$3.
