36	STATEMENT OF FACT
38	The amendment strikes sections of the bill repealing the Animal Welfare Board, the Animal Welfare Advisory Committee and
40	the Commission on Biotechnology and Genetic Engineering. Those boards would continue to operate, as under current law. The
42	amendment leaves intact Parts A and B, which repeal the Maine Agricultural Advisory Committee and the Integrated Pest
44	Management Advisory Committee, which have not been active in the past year. The amendment strikes a reference to the Integrated
46	Pest Management Advisory Committee which was not stricken in the bill.
