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Amend the bill by striking out all of Parts A, B, C, D and E 18 (page 1, lines 3 to 45 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in Part F by inserting before section 1 the following:

'Sec. F-1. 5 MRSA §298, 5th ¶, as amended by PL 1987, c. 816, Pt. EE, §3, is further amended to read:

The Director of Public Improvements shall--serve serves as 26 secretariat of the commission in exercising the its 28 administration. The commission may, in accordance with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, chapter 375, adopt and enforce 30 rules as it deems determines necessary, except rules relating to the State Capitol Building under the jurisdiction of the State 32 Capitel-Commission State House and Capitol Park Commission, as it deems determines necessary for the purposes of carrying out this 34 These rules shall have the full force and-effect of chapter. law.'

Further amend the bill in Part F by inserting after section 38 F-1 the following:

'**Sec. F-2. 27 MRSA §86-A, first ¶,** as amended by PL 1987, c. 816, Pt. EE, §6, is further amended to read:

The Maine State Museum shall-hold holds title, as trustee for the State, to all historical materials, other than documents or other library or archival items under the administrative jurisdiction of the Maine State Library or the Maine State Archives, which that are or may become the property of the State and are or may be housed in the public buildings of the State. Such These historical materials shall include the banners and

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flags presently housed in the State House Hall of Flags and may 2 include, but shall are not be restricted to, paintings, sculptures and other works of art dealing with historic subjects 4 or executed by historically significant artists; flags, banners, insignia, medals, firearms, edged weapons, uniforms and other accoutrements relating to Maine military personnel or units; 6 furnishings, utensils, implements, tools, machinery and other 8 devices having particular historical significance to the State. The State Capitol Building shall-be is in the jurisdiction of the 10 State-Gapitel-Gemmission State House and Capitol Park Commission.' 12 Further amend the bill in Part F by renumbering the sections to read consecutively. 14 Further amend the bill by striking out all of Parts G and H 16 (page 2, lines 5 to 20 in L.D.) Further amend the bill in Part I by inserting before section 18 I-1 the following: 20 'Sec. I-1. 2 MRSA §1, 4th ¶, as repealed and replaced by PL 1985, c. 693, §1, is repealed.' 22 24 Further amend the bill in Part I by renumbering the sections to read consecutively. 26 Further amend the bill in Part J by inserting after_section 28 J-1 the following: 30 'Sec. J-2. 5 MRSA §351, as amended by PL 1991, c. 780, Pt. Y, §29, is repealed. 32 Sec. J-3. 5 MRSA §352, as amended by PL 1985, c. 785, Pt. 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Removes Part A of the bill, thereby retaining the 1. Archives Advisory Board; 14

Removes Part B of the bill, thereby retaining the 2. Educational Leave Advisory Board;

3. Removes Part C of the bill, thereby retaining the Board of Emergency Municipal Finance; 20

4 Removes Part D of the bill, thereby retaining the Local Government Records Board;

Removes Part E of the bill, thereby retaining the 5. regional councils of governments; 26

28 6. Adds necessary language amending cross-references to the State Capitol Commission;

7. Removes Part G of the bill, thereby retaining the 32 Capitol Planning Commission;

8. Removes Part H of the bill, thereby retaining the State 34 House and Capitol Park Commission;

۹. Amends Parts I and the bill amend J of to cross-references to the State Compensation Commission, 38 the Advisory Committee on State Telecommunication and Maine-New Hampshire Boundary Commission and to repeal elements of the laws 40 relating to those entities; and

10. Removes Part L of the bill, thereby retaining the Maine-Canadian Legislative Advisory Commission. 44
