Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 17 MRSA §3861 is enacted to read:

<u>§3861. Trespass on landfill cover</u>

 A person who is not authorized by a municipality or the
State may not enter upon any landfill cover mound by any means. This section prohibits persons from riding or driving all-terrain
vehicles, snowmobiles, motorcycles, bicycles and other vehicles on landfill cover mounds. Any person who violates this section
commits a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not less than \$50 and not more than \$500, plus the cost of repair, may be
adjudged. For purposes of determining a forfeiture, each incident is considered a separate violation.

STATEMENT OF FACT

22 The purpose of this bill is to prevent damage to landfill cover mounds by vehicular and pedestrian traffic, which could 24 result in danger to the public health and welfare as well as requiring expensive repair work. This bill prohibits trespass on 26 landfill cover mounds by any unauthorized persons.

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
