Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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		Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §1354, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1975, c
4	740,	§124, is amended to read:

2. The commission shall propose <u>submit</u> to the Legislature, at the start of each session, such changes in the criminal laws and in related provisions as the commission may deem <u>determine</u> appropriate. The commission may also make recommendations to the Judicial Council, the Advisory Committee on Criminal Rules and to any other organization or committee whose affairs pertain to the criminal justice system.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill clarifies the authority of the Criminal Law Advisory Commission to submit legislation at the start of each session.
