6 §13791. Return of drugs

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

A drug or pharmaceutical preparation which <u>that</u> has been dispensed on prescription shall-net may be returned to pharmacy
stock after being in possession and under the control of another person and shall-net may be dispensed again,-unless <u>if</u> the drug
is packaged in an unbroken, sealed container or unless <u>if</u>, in the case of a hospital, a licensed pharmacist determines that the drug has not been impaired.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill clarifies that nursing homes may accept returned drugs.

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
