HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 948,
L.D. 1277, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the
Constitution of Maine to Provide the Governor with a Line-item
Veto"

Amend the amendment in subsection 2-A in the 4th line (page
1, line 24 in amendment) by inserting after the following:
"document." the following: 'Unless the Governor exercises the
line-item veto power authorized in this Section no later than one
day after receiving for signature the enacted legislation, the
powers of the Governor as set out in Section 2 apply to the
entire enacted legislation.'

Further amend the amendment in subsection 2-A in the 4th
line from the end (page 1, line 36 in amendment) by inserting
after the following: "veto" the following: 'and each item vetoed
must be voted on separately to override the veto'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires that the Governor exercise the
line-item veto power no later than one day after receiving for
signature the enacted legislation and requires that each item
vetoed be voted on separately to override the veto.
