

STATEMENT OF FACT

8 This resolution proposes an amendment to the Constitution of
10 Maine to give the Governor a line-item veto over appropriations
and allocations. Under the terms of the proposed amendment, a
12 veto of an appropriation or allocation may be overridden by a
majority vote of all the elected members of the Senate and the
House of Representatives.
