28	This bill establishes a new Class E crime. Sentences imposed for Class E offenses must be served in a county jail.
30	The average cost per sentence for a Class E crime is \$4,685 based upon an average length of stay of 67 days. The additional costs
32	to the counties for the housing of each offender sentenced under this new crime are not reimbursed by the State.

36	The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system
38	can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " to H.P. 969, L.D. 1300

The Department of Corrections has prepared the following correctional impact statement pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 34-A, section 1402: "L.D. 1300, An Act Regarding Disorderly Conduct expands the existing law on disorderly conduct to include loud and unreasonable noise from agricultural machinery as a Class E offense.

8 "A sentence imposed for a Class E offense must be served in a county jail facility. Looking at sentences served for Class E offenses in county jails, the average length of stay was found to be about 67 days. The average costs per day in a county jail is \$62.51. The average cost per sentence for a Class E crime is \$4,188."
