HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 978, L.D. 1309, Bill, "An Act to Authorize Sagadahoc County to Provide Centralized Administrative Services to Those Sagadahoc County Municipalities That Desire to Share the Cost of Those Services"

Amend the bill in section 1 by inserting at the end the following:

§1409. Sunset

This chapter is repealed on July 1, 1995. Representatives of eligible counties specified in section 1408 may recommend to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters that the Legislature extend authorization of this chapter.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment establishes a date of July 1, 1995 for the termination of centralized administrative services by certain counties. The amendment also requires that recommendations for continued authorization of the program be made to the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government.
