

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §2296-B, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1991, c.
4 597, §29, is further amended to read:

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1. **Petition.** A person whose license to operate a motor
vehicle has been revoked as an habitual offender, pursuant to
8 section 2293, 2296, 2296-A or 2298 may petition the Secretary of
State for a work-restricted license.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill expands the authority of the Secretary of State to
16 issue a work-restricted license to a person whose license has
been revoked under any of the habitual offender laws.

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
