2 4	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §2602, sub-§1, $\P\P$ F and G, as amended by PL 1989, c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, are further amended to read:
6	F. Failure to qualify for the office within 10 days after written demand by the municipal officers; ΘF
8 10	G. Failure of the municipality to elect a person to office .; or
12	Sec. 2. 30-A MRSA §2602, sub-§1, ¶H is enacted to read:
14	H. The successful recall of an elected official pursuant to section 2608.
16 18	Sec. 3. 30-A MRSA §2608 is enacted to read:
20	§2608. Recall of elected municipal officials
22	Any person holding an elective municipal office is subject to recall and discharge by the legal voters of the municipality subject to the following provisions.
24	1. Petition. A petition demanding recall and reciting that
26	the municipal official has committed some act or acts of malfeasance or misfeasance while in office or has violated the oath of office and describing those acts in 200 words or less
30	must be signed by a number of voters qualified to vote in the recall election at least equal to 35% of the number of votes cast for all candidates for that person's office at the preceding
32	election.
34	2. Filing. This petition must be filed with the town clerk who shall verify the signatures and call a special election if
36 38	required. In the event that the person being recalled is the town clerk, the chief municipal officer shall carry out this duty.
40	3. Election. A recall election must be held within 30 days of the verification of the signatures on the petition.
42	4. Ballot. The ballot at the election must describe in not more than 200 words the recalled officer's justification for the
