40	This amendment prohibits the Board of Environmental Protection from adopting all or any part of a water quality
42	criterion that would regulate dioxin in the waters of this State prior to January 1, 1994. The Legislature believes that the
44	resources of the Department of Environmental Protection and the State of Maine would be poorly spent in devoting time to
46	ascertaining an appropriate criterion for dioxin until the federal Environmental Protection Agency has released its final scientific summary of the human health effects of exposure to
