An Act to Amend the Charter of the Plymouth Water District.
(AFTER DEADLINE)

Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 27. Reference to the Committee on Utilities suggested and ordered printed.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. $\mathbb{P} \& S L 1991$, c. 37,82 , is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

The district is obligated to supply water for only the 47 residences in the district that would otherwise have access to only contaminated water or water that is in imminent danger of becoming contaminated as identified in the document entitled "AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF MAINE AND THE PLYMOUTH WATER DISTRICT REGARDING THE PLYMOUTH WATER SYSTEM," dated April 2 . 1993.

Sec. 2. $\mathbb{P} \& S L 1991$, c. $37, \$ 9$, sulb- $\$ 2-A$ is enacted to read:
2-A. Elections. An annual meeting must be held on the 2nd Monday in October for the purpose of electing officers.

## STATRMENT OF FACT

The bill amends Charter of the Plymouth Water District in 2 ways.

1. The bill clarifies that the district is obligated to supply water for only the 47 residences identified in an agreement between the district trustees and the Department of Environmental Protection.
2. The bill requires that an annual meeting be held the 2 nd Monday in October to elect officers.
