HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1014, L.D. 1360, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Powers and Duties of Municipal Officials of the New Town of Long Island"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. P&SL 1991, c. 100, Pt. A, §4 is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

Elected or appointed municipal officers, officials or school board members may exercise any official authority necessary to implement full municipal government activities on July 1, 1993.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies the intent of the bill to define the authority of local officials to act before the incorporation of the Town of Long Island on July 1, 1993.
