The Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices will require an additional allocation of \$36,731 in fiscal year 1993-94 and \$48,323 in fiscal year 1994-95 to provide funds for a Lobbyist Registrar position and general operating expenses to assume this new responsibility. A corresponding deallocation is required from the Secretary of State in the same amounts indicated above.

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This bill establishes a public Campaign Financing Trust Fund that will be overseen by the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices and will derive its revenue from donations

from taxpayers. The anticipated increase in revenue and required allocations to administer the program can not be determined at this time.

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The Legislature will require a General Fund appropriation of \$5,460 in fiscal year 1993-94 for the costs related to a study by the Joint Standing Committee on Legal Affairs of possible sources of funding for the Campaign Financing Trust Fund.

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The Bureau of Taxation will require additional General Fund appropriations of \$8,253 and \$3,496 in fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95, respectively, for the costs related to establishing a contributions checkoff for the Campaign Financing Trust Fund on the individual income tax return. Another \$2,000 per year will be deducted from the contributions to cover administrative costs incurred by the Bureau of Taxation.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment adds an appropriation section, an allocation section and a fiscal note to the bill.

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This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Legal Affairs.
