28	regardless of the amount-due-in-the-bill number of other services provided. If-a-late-fee-is-charged-on-more-than-one-level-of
30	service, -it-must-be-calculated-on-the-total-dollar-amount-of-such services, -and-may-not-be-calculated-separately-on-each-service-to
32	which-it-applies-and-then-cumulated. A payment is not late under this subsection until at least 30 45 days after those services to
