SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 490, L.D. 1501, Bill, "An Act to Modify Various Licensing Board Laws"

Amend the amendment by striking out the first indented 18 paragraph after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 1 to 13.

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 14 and 24 inserting in its place the following:

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'Sec. 14. 32 MRSA §1507 is enacted to read:

28 §1507. Inactive status

·30 A licensee who is no longer actively practicing funeral service may surrender the licensee's active license to the State Board of Funeral Service and request inactive license status. An 32 applicant for inactive status may not practice funeral service 34 either in the State or in any other state, province or territory. The board may place the licensee on inactive status only upon proper application and the submission of appropriate 36 fees by the licensee. The holder of an inactive status license 38 is required to renew the license annually but is not required to meet the continuing education requirement required by this 40 chapter and the rules adopted under it.

42 <u>A holder of an inactive license who wishes to reinstate that holder's active license must comply with the continuing education</u>
44 <u>requirement and fees provided in this chapter and the rules adopted under it.'</u>

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 490, L.D. 1501

Further amend the bill by striking out all of sections 15, 16, 18, 19, 23 to 25 and 40 to 59.' **STATEMENT OF FACT** This amendment adds a provision allowed holders of a license from the Board of Funeral Service to obtain an inactive status license.
