Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174, 4th ¶, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 714, §3, is amended to read:

The application of any available insurance, other 3rd party liabilities or other benefits to which the applicant may be entitled or the determination of other eligibility factors shall <u>must</u> be in accordance with federal matching requirements. <u>To the</u> <u>extent permitted by federal law, the amount of long-term care</u> <u>insurance coverage is not considered an asset for purposes of</u> <u>determining eligibility under this chapter.</u>

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that, to the extent permitted by federal law, the amount of long-term care insurance coverage is sheltered from consideration in determining Medicaid eligibility.

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
