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SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 497, L.D. 1517, Bill, "An Act to Make Additional Appropriations and Allocations and to Make Technical Corrections to the Laws for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1993 and June 30, 1994"

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Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

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PART K

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Sec. K-1. Funds for special education and supportive services. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15613, subsection 15, the Commissioner of Education is authorized in fiscal year 1992-93 to expend funds in the General Purpose Aid Account in excess of those appropriated for special education and supportive services provided to state agency clients, based upon available cash produced by construction aid audit recoveries.'

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Further amend the bill by relettering the parts to read consecutively.

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FISCAL NOTE


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This amendment may reduce the balances carrying forward in the General Purpose Aid for Local Schools account at the end of fiscal year 1992-93.
