Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days 22 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 24 Whereas, unless this legislation is enacted as an emergency 26 measure, the school construction project already underway for Ellsworth High School will be seriously jeopardized; 28 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts 30 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately 32 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,' 34 Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the 36

statement of fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.'

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This amendment makes the resolve an emergency measure.
