An Act to Revise the Salaries of Certain County Officers.

(EMERGENCY)

Reported by Representative JOSEPH for the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government pursuant to Joint Order H.P. 115.

Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local units of government to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, it has become necessary to revise the salaries of certain county officials; and

Whereas, it is desired to have these revisions retroactive to January 1, 1993; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §2, sub-§1, as repealed and replaced by PL 1991, c. 852, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

30 1. County officers' salaries. Notwithstanding other sections of this chapter, counties that are not required to 32 obtain legislative approval of their budgets under section 702 are not required to obtain legislative approval of the salaries 34 of county officers under this section. The county commissioners, treasurers, sheriffs, judges of probate, registers of probate and 36 registers of deeds in those counties whose budgets require legislative approval under section 702 are entitled to receive in 38 weekly, biweekly or monthly payments annual salaries from the county treasury as follows:

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved and applies retroactively to January 1, 1993.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires local units of government to make additional expenditures for any increases in county salaries. Pursuant to the mandate preamble, the 2/3 vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local cost of these 14 requirements.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill enacts the 1993 salaries of county officers.
