Con 1 20 BATDCA CIII A A
Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §114-A is enacted to read:
\$114-A. Antique vehicles; nonresidents
The Secretary of State may issue registration plates to a
nonresident for antique autos, horseless carriages, street rods
or antique motorcycles as long as the motor vehicle remains in
the State.
STATEMENT OF FACT
This bill allows nonresidents to receive antique license
plates if the motor vehicle remains in the State.
