### STATE OF MAINE SENATE 116TH LEGISLATURE SECOND REGULAR SESSION

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 573, L.D. 1617, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Display of Social Security Numbers on Insurance-related Identification Cards"

Amend the bill by inserting after the emergency clause and before the statement of fact the following:

#### FISCAL NOTE

Permitting the use of social security numbers as identification for medical insurance will avoid a cost to the State's employee health insurance program of approximately \$42,000 in fiscal year 1993-94. Of the total cost, which would result from computer reprogramming and the issuance of new identification cards, approximately \$21,000 would be attributable to the General Fund and \$6,300 to the Highway Fund.'

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
