	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 4	Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §75, sub-§6, \P B, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 849, §2, is amended to read:
б	B. The board shall consist of 8 members appointed as follows:
8	(1) One horse puller andone-oxpuller appointed by
10 12	the Maine Draft Horse and Ox Association, <u>one ox puller</u> appointed by the Pine Tree Ox Association and one pony puller appointed by the Pony Association;
