STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment repeals references in the Maine Revised Statutes, Titles 5 and 30-A to the Maine School Building Authority and moves language repealed by the bill to another section of Title 20-A to maintain the Commissioner of Education's authority to take land for school purposes in the unorganized territory.
