This amendment changes the classification of the main stem of the Presumpscot River from the outlet of Dundee Pond to its confluence with the Pleasant River from Class B to Class A. Provision is made to retain the Class B aquatic life standard for this river segment for the purposes of federal relicensing of the Dundee Dam hydropower project. This amendment also retains the GP-A classification of the existing impoundment behind the Dundee Dam which had been inadvertently reclassified to a riverine classification in the original bill.
