This amendment represents the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. It provides funding for 12 positions through a General Fund line category transfer from the All Other line category to the Personal Services line category within the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation to maintain certain state-staffed mental health crisis programs in fiscal year 1994-95 while allowing certain mental health crisis programs to privatize as enacted by the First Regular Session of the 116th Legislature.
