Sec. 1. School administrative district for Aroostook County authorized. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, sections 1201 and 1202, the State Board of Education shall take the necessary actions to establish the municipalities within Aroostook County as a single school administrative district.
