4	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6131, sub-§3, as repealed and replaced by PL 1981, c. 433, §3, is amended to read:
6	3. Closed period in rivers and streams not under lease agreement. In any river or stream not managed under a lease
8	agreement, there is a 24-heur <u>72-hour</u> closed period on the taking of alewives and obstruction of the watercourse to allow the free
10	passage of fish from 6 a.m. on Saturday Thursday to 6 a.m. the following Sunday.
