

**Sec. 1. Allocation.** The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue to carry out the purposes of this Act.

This bill includes an Other Special Revenue allocation of \$15,700 in fiscal year 1994-95 for the Board of Osteopathic Examination and Registration to increase the Executive Secretary position from 1/2-time to full-time. The board has sufficient revenue in its unallocated reserves to support the upgrade in the position without increasing fees.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This bill allocates Other Special Revenue to increase the Executive Secretary position for the Board of Osteopathic Examination and Registration from a 1/2-time to a full-time position in order to accommodate the board's need for administrative support.
