Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted 2 as emergencies; and 4 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and б Whereas, a significant funding shortfall exists in the Maine 8 Residents Property Tax Program; and 10 Whereas, it is important to satisfy all remaining qualified 12 fiscal year 1993-94 applicants as soon as possible; and 14 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 16 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 18 safety; now, therefore, 20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: Sec. 1.
