Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 27. Reference to the Committee on Transportation suggested and ordered printed.

Resolved: That, notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 23, chapter 21, the Department of Transportation is directed to construct 2 signs on Interstate 95 indicating the Bath, Brunswick and Topsham Recreational Region. One sign must be erected before Exit 22 going north and the other sign must be erected before Exit 24 going south.
