COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "^B" to H.P. 1358, L.D. 1833, Bill, "An Act to Reinstitute Stipends for Professional Staff at State Mental Health Institutions"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Reinstitute Stipends for Professional Staff at State Mental Health Institutions and the Governor Baxter School for the Deaf'

Further amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §7065, sub-§2, as repealed and replaced by PL 1989, c. 418, §§1 and 4, is amended to read:

2. Salary limits. No position may be assigned a salary greater than the maximum or less than the minimum rates fixed in the compensation plan except as provided by subsections ~~2-A~~ and ~~2-B~~ subsection 2-D.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2-D in the 5th line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "institutions" the following: 'and the Governor Baxter School for the Deaf'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:
