### Revenues

Other Funds \$30,600

This bill includes an Other Special Revenue allocation of \$30,600 in fiscal year 1994-95 for the Division of Licensing and Enforcement to establish a Clerk Typist III position needed to internal the Department of adequately support boards to Professional and Financial Regulation. Funds for the position will be provided proportionally by each board the position supports, increasing dedicated revenue to the division by \$30,600 in fiscal year 1994-95.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This bill allocates Other Special Revenue to establish a Clerk Typist III position in the Division of Licensing and Enforcement within the Department of Professional and Financial 20 Regulation. A percentage of this position's time will support 2 22 boards recommended for internalization in related legislation; the balance of the position's time will be dedicated to other 24 boards. Each board will provide funds for the position in direct proportion to the amount of support received.
